The Rebbe was born in Boston, Massachusetts in 1946. In 1970, he founded, Yeshiva MaChzukei Torah, serving as Dean of the college for the next nine years. Later that year he assisted his father, The Bostoner Rebbe zt"l, establish Kollel Boston in Jerusalem, Israel, and is today its spiritual leader.

In 1989, the Rebbe shlit"a made Aliyah to Eretz Yisroel and became very involved in Agudas Yisroel and in building Torah communities for English-speaking olim. Some Achievements while living in Israel:

- 1990-Present: Talmud Torah Boston; Bnei Brak, Israel; Founder & President.
- 1995-2000; Beis Shalom D'Boston; Har Nof, Yerushalayim, Founder, Builder and Rabbi.
- 1999-2009; Boston Beitar Synagogue in Beitar, Founder, Builder and Rabbi.
- 2004-Present: 1 of 5 Members of the Board of Rabbis, Chinuch Atzmei.
- 2006-Present: Machon HaNesher HaGadol, Founder, whose goal is to publish the Rambam's Mishnah Torah with analysis and sources.
- 2009-Present: 1 of 13 members of the Moetzes Agudas Yisroel.
- 2012-Present: Launched publication Kasher English in conjunction with the Jerusalem Post.
