



Tisha B'Av 5778 Schedule, Laws & Customs **(Tentative)**

Shabbos Chazon Erev Tisha B'Av Nidcheh (pushed off), 9 Menachem Av

Chatzos: 1:03pm

- Minhag to only learn subjects permitted on Tisha B'Av, therefore Pirkei Avos is not recited.

Inyanei D'Yoma (for Ladies) TBA

PreTisha B'av Shiur: 5:15 Rabbi Herman Main Shul

- "Aggadata Related to Tish'a B'Av"

Mincha: 6:00 Main Shul

- Although all public manifestations of aveilus (mourning) that are practiced on Tisha B'Av are not permitted to take place on Shabbos (until the time it concludes), eating and washing are prohibited after sundown 8:22pm.
- Shalos seudos, at home, must be completed before 8:22pm.
- Shabbos clothes and shoes are to be worn until the conclusion of Shabbos, 9:12.
- After 9:12, if one did not daven Maariv, *baruch ha'mavdil bein kadosh la'chol* should be said and then leather shoes should be removed and Shabbos clothes may be changed.

Maariv followed by Eicha: 9:40 Goldfischer Gym

- After having concluded Shabbos by saying *baruch ha'mavdil bein kadosh la'chol*, Shabbos is over and one is permitted to drive to shul.
- In the Amidah one adds *Ata Chonantonu* even though *baruch ha'mavdil* was already said.
- Before Eicha a bracha on the fire of a havdalah candle is made.
- Anyone not fasting or not completing the fast needs to recite havdalah before eating. The havdalah is made on *chamar medina*, social drink, such as beer, tea or coffee. The first paragraph is omitted; only the *brachos* on the cup and *hamavdil* are said.

Tisha B'Av Nidcheh day, 10 Menachem Av

- Tefillin & Talleisim are not worn
- **9:00** minyan will have two kinos venues:

Motzei Tisha B'Av Nidcheh: Due to it being the night after the 10th of Av the following are laws of the evening and the following day:

- Havdalah can be made on wine. The first paragraph is omitted; only the *brachos* on the cup and *hamavdil* are said.
- Showering, laundering, haircuts and music are permitted.
- Meat is permitted the next morning

May everyone have an easy and meaningful Tisha B'Av and through it be zocheh to the promise taught by our sages that whoever mourns over Jerusalem will merit the future vision of her joy, as it is written in Isaiah (Chapter 66, verse 10), "rejoice greatly with her, all who mourn her."
